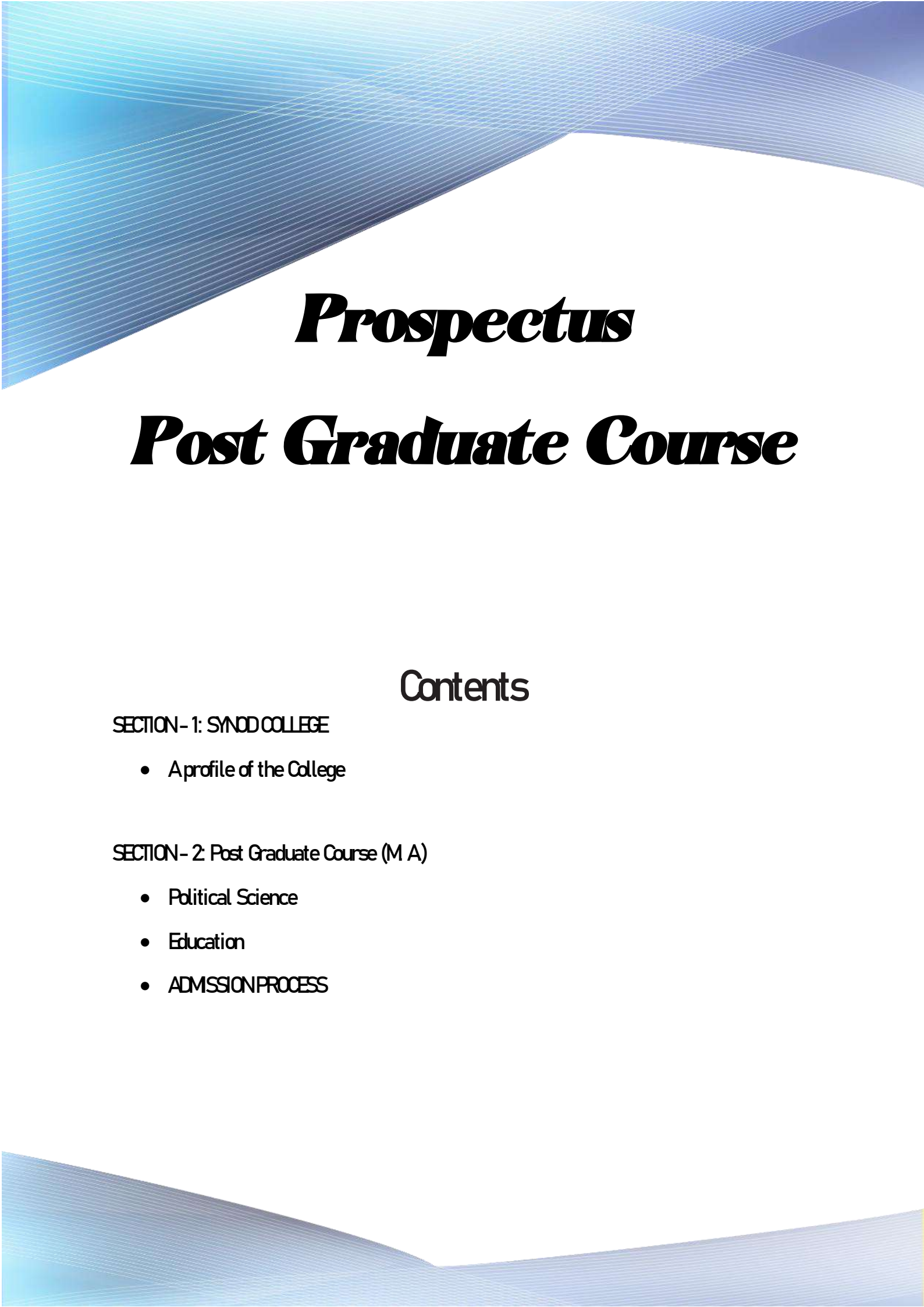

A Profile of Synod College Shillong

Synod College, Shillong is a premier institution of higher learning established in 1965 under the initiative of the Khasi Jaintia Presbyterian Synod Sepngi, the governing body of the Khasi Jaintia Presbyterian Church. The College is managed by the Synod and operates with the core mission of imparting quality higher education, particularly to the youth of Meghalaya, and more broadly to students from across the northeastern region and other parts of India.

The College is registered under the Societies Registration Act of 1890 (Registration No. SR/SC-6/75 of 1975) and was included under Sections 2(f) and 12(B) of the University Grants Commission (UGC) Act, 1956, in the year 1976. As a deficit grant-in-aid college of the Government of Meghalaya, it receives financial assistance from the state government, UGC, and other central government agencies.

Originally affiliated with Gauhati University at its inception, the College has been affiliated with the North-Eastern Hill University (NEHU) since 1973. Over the decades, Synod College has grown from modest beginnings into one of the most reputed colleges in the region, recognized for its commitment to academic excellence, character-building, and service.

The College currently employs over 100 teaching and non-teaching staff and offers undergraduate programs in Arts, Science, and Commerce, along with a professional course in Computer Applications. It offers 15 undergraduate degree programs, all of which have Honours options, catering to a student population of over 2,000 from diverse socio-economic backgrounds across both urban and rural areas of Northeast India.

NAAC Accreditation and Re-accreditation

In its commitment to maintaining and enhancing quality in higher education, Synod College proactively undertook the process of external evaluation by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bengaluru.

The College was assessed based on the following seven key criteria:

- Curricular Aspects
- Teaching-Learning and Evaluation
- Research, Consultancy and Extension
- Infrastructure and Learning Resources
- Student Support and Progression
- Governance, Leadership and Management
- Institutional Values and Best Practices

Synod College achieved its first NAAC Accreditation in September 2005 with a B+ Grade. It was subsequently Re-accredited in November 2011 and again in September 2017, both times securing an 'A' Grade and in the 2023 securing 'A+' reflecting the College's consistent efforts toward institutional development, academic rigor, and holistic student support.

POST GRADUATE COURSE (M.A.) MASTER OF ARTS IN POLITICAL SCIENCE

In the year 2016, Synod College made another milestone by introducing the Post Graduate Course (Master's Degree) in Political Science. This programme (M.A Political Science) is affiliated to the North-Eastern Hill University. The seats for this course are limited to a maximum of 50. The main objective of this course is to provide an opportunity for students to study at the higher level in the concerned department and also to give them a platform to delve deeper into their areas of interest within this discipline. An honours graduate in Political Science with a minimum of 45% of marks is eligible to apply. The tenth batch of students, session 2025-26 will commence classes in the month of August 2025.

This M.A Programme is based on two-semesters of orientation and basic courses (core courses) to be completed in a one-year period, followed by two semesters of specialization to be covered in the following year. The final semester gives the students the opportunity to work on their term Dissertation. The evaluation of the students is made at two levels: (a) sessional evaluation (25%) consisting of tests, writing of term papers and semester seminar presentation during the coursework of the semester. (b) The external evaluation is made to assess the performance of the students in the final examination, at the end of the semester.

Admissions to PG Courses: Master of Arts (M.A) in Political Science

Application in the prescribed format for admission to M.A in Political Science will be accepted by the College immediately after the announcement of the B.A. Final year results of the North-Eastern Hill University. When submitting the applications, candidates will have to attach an attested copy of the mark sheet of the final year examination.

Admission Procedure:

Application form for admission along with one copy of prospectus shall be available in the College office/College website www.synodcollege.com on the dates as notified in the advertisement. Each duly filled in application form is to be accompanied with the mark sheet of the last examination at the time of submission. Mark sheet downloaded from the internet is also provisionally accepted. How to apply?

1. Duly filled in application form accompanied with photocopies of all attested testimonials are to be submitted in the office of the College on or before the last date of submission.
2. No application received thereafter shall be entertained on any ground whatsoever. The College will not be responsible for any delay in receipt or loss of applications in postal transit.
3. Application form must be accompanied with the following:
 - a) Attested copy of Admit Card and Mark-sheet of the last Examination.
 - b) Pass certificate and testimonial of character from the head of the Institution last attended.
 - c) Recent passport-size photograph
 - d) A photocopy of either Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe Certificate in case of those students belonging to either category.
 - e) Students migrating from another institution/University will also have to submit the Migration Certificate in original.
4. The application form is to be filled in by the candidate himself/herself. The College authority reserves the right to refuse admission without assigning any reason thereof.
5. In case any candidate is found to have furnished false information or false certificate etc. or is found to have withheld or concealed any material information, his/her application will be debarred for admission.
6. It will be the responsibility of the candidate to ensure that correct address is

entered in the application form. The College will not be responsible for any loss in transit or for incorrect address given by the applicant in the application form.

Instruction for Photograph submission

- Two (2) recent high contrast passport size photographs with light background are required. Polaroid photos are not acceptable.
- Photograph must be taken on or after 1st January, 2025.
- Photograph should not have cap or sunglasses. Spectacles are allowed.
- One photograph should be pasted (not stapled) on the application form. The photograph pasted on the application form should be unattested.
- Another photograph for identity card to be submitted only after admission is granted.
- Application not complying with these instructions or with unclear photographs will be rejected.

Eligibility and Procedure of Selection

- Admission to the 1st Semester of the two years PG programme (M.A. in Political Science) shall be selected in order of merit of the last university examination on first-come-first serve basis after personal interview with the Principal. The College may also conduct a written test for admission if necessary.
- Candidates who passed from NEHU with Honours in Political Science would be given first preference for admission to this course whereas second preference would be given to candidates having B.A. (Major) in allied subject. Preference would also be given to those students who passed out from the Colleges affiliated to NEHU.
- Selected candidates must pay the fees within the stipulated time given. Failure to pay the admission fees before the date and time specified, the seat would stand forfeited.
- In case the available seats are not filled after the last date of admission for

selected candidates, the remaining seats will be given to those in the waiting list.

- After timely payment of fees, the candidate is considered to be provisionally admitted. The admission is confirmed after verification of the marks secured by the candidate from the original mark-sheet issued by the University concerned.

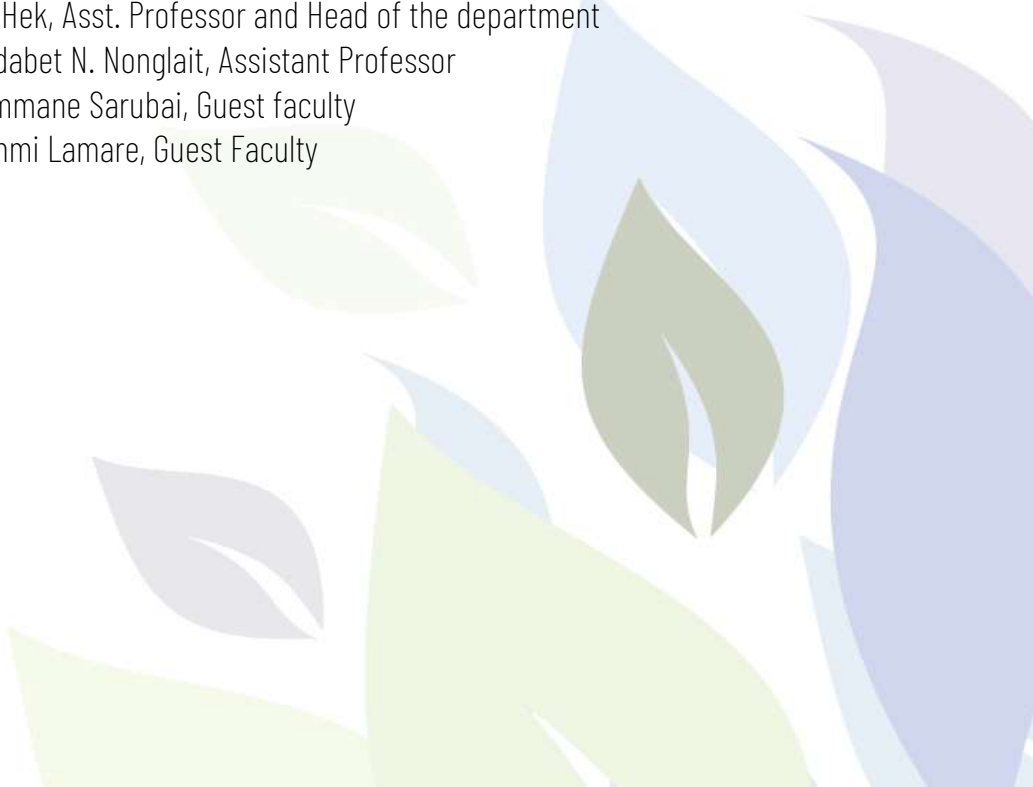

Admissions to Master of Arts (M.A) in Education

Q. When to apply?

Application in the prescribed format for admission to M.A in Education will be accepted by the college immediately after the announcement of the B.A. final year results of the North Eastern Hill University. When submitting the applications, candidates will have to attach an attested copy of the mark sheet of the final year examination.

Q. Who can apply?

First preference will be given to candidates having 45% Bachelor degree honours in Education. A candidate with 55% in B.Ed/ M.Ed. are also eligible to apply for admission to M.A. Education course. (5% will be relaxable for SC/ST candidates)

Q. How to apply?

1. Register on our application portal with your email address. To register click, Apply Online
2. After registration, check your email ID to verify the e-mail id and activate your registration.
3. Log-in using your email ID and password.
4. Proceed for payment of Application fee
5. After your payment of Application fee is successful you can fill up the Admission form and upload the required documents
6. Click Submit after you have filled the application.
7. Candidates will receive a notification in their mobile no or email regarding the successful submission of the application form.
8. The admission office will verify your documents after which you will receive an email regarding the status of your application.
9. Admission will be given on first-come first-serve on the basis of past academic record and performance.
10. Please ensure that you enter the correct data in your application form, incomplete form may not be submitted or accepted.
11. Please ensure that you have with you scan copies of the following documents for uploading (size of the document should not exceed 200kb)
12. Candidates who are shortlisted for admission will have to come for counselling and the candidates must produce Original and Xerox copy (self-attested) of the following documents

13. Candidates who have appear for counselling are to pay the admission fees within 24 hours.
 14. After payment of the fee, a copy of the transaction receipt (Student Name, Mode of payment,

UTR no, date of payment, amount and Bank with Branch name) must be uploaded in the WhatsApp group (which will be created) for seat confirmation.

15. Candidates will receive a notification in their mobile no or email regarding the acceptance of their admission. Other details like date of commencement of classes will also be notified to the students in the WhatsApp group (which will be created).
16. You are also requested to check the college website- <https://www.synodcollege.edu.in>, for any update and notifications.
17. Failing payment, the admission shall stand cancelled and the seat offered to other candidates.

Admission to the 1st Semester of the two years PG programme (M.A. in Education) shall be selected in order of CUET merit score. The College may also conduct a written test for Non-CUET candidates for admission if necessary.
